

2010 RSIS Project Details

1. Thailand (December 7th - 27th 2010)

This Project is again working alongside the Pakanyor Foundation in Northern Thailand to construct and establish an essential clean water system for the Karen village of Ban Den Hom in the Sameong District, about 1 hour's drive from Chiang Mai. Working alongside local villagers and the fantastic team from the Pakanyor Foundation, the group will be damming water sources, digging trenches, laying pipes and then building two new water storage tanks. After the Project work, the team will embark on a 4-day visit to Chiang Mai during which there will be one day at an elephant conservation Project, a half-day Thai cookery course, visits to local temples and plenty of market shopping!

Cost: The cost of the Project will be **£1,100** from arrival in Chiang Mai to departure from Chiang Mai. The cost does **not** include international travel or en route accommodation to/from the point of arrival/departure, visas, inoculations, personal spending money, or equipment. It **does** include all food, accommodation, transport, tours, visits and activities. All participants are automatically covered by the Round Square travel and medical insurance policy.

2. Honduras (December 4th to 22nd 2010)

We are delighted to return to Honduras again this year to work alongside our partner - Sociedad Amigos de los Ninos (SAN). The group will be working in the small village of Nuevo Paraiso, which is nestled in the mountains 2 hours from Tegucigalpa. There will be various tasks to work on including helping local people to build a carpentry training centre for the boys, helping with a medical camp for local people and holding computer classes and sports activities for the children. After the Project, the team will be going out to coast to visit some of the stunning national parks and beaches!

Cost: The cost of the Project will be £1200 from arrival in Tegucigalpa to departure from Tegucigalpa, and **does not** include the cost of international travel or en route accommodation to/from the point of arrival/departure, insurance, visas, inoculations, personal spending money, or equipment. It **does** include all food, accommodation, transport, visits and activities. All international participants are automatically covered under the Round Square travel and medical insurance policy.

3. India - (December 6th/7th to December 27th for International Students; December 8th to December 22nd for Indian students)

We are really excited to be working with The Daly College and the Barli Institute in Indore this year on a community environmental Project. The team will be working alongside the Barli Institute to help construct a wind-generator, some solar panelling, lighting and solar cooking stoves for a disadvantaged community on the outskirts of Indore. As well as construction work, the team will have plenty of interaction with villagers - learning some solar cooking as well as giving presentations to them on your own country and sustainable living ideas. There is a mid-Project break exploring the amazing sites of Mandu and Maheshwar, and after the Project, the International team will be going to see the sites of Agra and Jaipur (including the Taj Mahal). Indian students are welcome to join the International team on the cultural tours in Agra and Jaipur.

Cost (Indore Project only): The cost of the Project for Indian students will be £500 from arrival in Indore to departure from Indore. The cost **does not** include travel or en route accommodation to/from the point of arrival/departure, personal spending money, or equipment. It **does** include all activities, tours, food, accommodation and transport. All Indian participants must provide proof of medical insurance cover.

Cost (Indore Project plus Agra/Jaipur Cultural Phase): The cost of the Project **and** the 5-day cultural tour for Indian students will be £1020 from arrival in Indore to departure from Delhi. This **does** include the cost of travel from Indore to Agra/Jaipur and on to Delhi on December 27th.
