

ISG students excel in the CBSE Senior Secondary Exams

Students of Indian School Al Ghubra have performed exceedingly well in the CBSE Senior Secondary Examinations for the year 2010-11.

A total of 118 students appeared for the exams in both Science and Commerce stream of whom 104 secured distinction. ISG has once again created history with not just a 100% pass result with no compartmental in any subject as well.

Of the 78 students who appeared in the Science Stream, 69 scored 80% and above of which 35 scored 90% and above marks. It is indeed a marvelous achievement that almost 50% of the students have scored above 90%.

In the Commerce Stream of the 40 students who took the exam, 29 scored a distinction and 38 scored a First Class.

In the Science stream, George Justin secured 96.8% and topped the list, followed by Nayantara Prem scoring 96 % in the second position. Sachin Mathew and Naveen G Anand scored 95.8 % marks and bagged the third place.
