

ISG swimmers prove their mettle at the CBSE National Swimming Meet



The students of Indian School Al Ghubra clinched medals at the CBSE Nationals held at Sagar Public School, Bhopal on November 2011. After their exceptional performance at the Clusters 10 girls 5 boys represented ISG at the National Meet. ISG has continued its unbeaten winning streak for the 8th consecutive year.
