The students studying in classes VIII to XI have been invited to attend the Youth Training Programme (YTP), at United Nations, Geneva, from **17th June to 21st June 2019**. YTP is a programme designed especially for our students amongst all schools in the Gulf and India region.

YTP helps students to talk to high level professionals in a number of fields that they normally do not have access to. Besides the knowledge they acquire from these “first hand” actors of the international relations, the “immersion” concept that YTP follow implies that students leave Geneva with concepts and ideas having been imprinted in their mind in a way that is closer to an experience than simple knowledge acquisition. At the end of the course, students will be awarded certificate of participation and recommendation letters for future references.

The amount to be deposited as conference fee is RO 1600/- (it includes stay at the hotel, delegate fees, airport transfers, food , air fare , Swiss Schengen visa charges , insurance and tour of Chamonix.)

Please do pay a non- refundable deposit of RO150/- to the school bank account by 18th March 2019. The balance amount may be paid on or before 28th March 2019. In case of withdrawal of your ward from the conference for any reason the non – refundable amount will not be returned. (by the organizers due to cancellation / withdrawal.)

Please do submit your ward’s passport copy and consent form to Mrs Maleka Ariwala by 18th March 2019.
