Swimmers bring laurels to ISG



Purva Deshmukh and Siddharth Vaz lead medal haul

The swimmers of ISG once again proved their mettle with their stupendous performance at the CBSE National Swimming Meet held at Delhi Public School ,Rohtak, India. At the Meet, held from 29 October to 2 November, ISG fielded 25 of its ace swimmers of who 9 won medals in the various categories.

The star of the event was Purva Suhas Deshmukh, a student of class 10, who bagged the Gold in the 200mtr butterfly, Silver in the 100 mtr butterfly and Bronze in 400mtr individual medley, 4x100 mtr medley relay and 4x100 mtr freestyle relay. Purva has clinched the gold medal in her favourite butterfly stroke event at the CBSE National Meet in 2007, 2008 and 2009. She has hence completed a hat trick this year. She is the first and the only girl swimmer in the Gulf Region to have achieved such a feat. This young teen has pocketed more than 160 individual medals at the various National and International Swimming Meets. Purva has also won the silver medal in the Sea Swimming competition organized by the Oman Swimming Association.

Siddhart Vaz put forth yet another sterling performance bagging the bronze medal in the U-19 50 mtr freestyle event. At the Nationals held in 2006 and 2007, Siddharth had clinched the bronze in the U-14 50 mtr freestyle and U-16 100 mtr butterfly respectively. He is the only boy in the Gulf region to have won an individual medal at the Nationals held in Rohtak this year.



The other achievers at the Zonal meet were –Yash Asher, Parth Deshmukh Aditya Jayakumar and Arjun Shriyan who clinched the Bronze in the 4x100 mtr Freestyle relay. Manasa Naik, Harshinee S and Richa John also won the bronze in 4x100 mtr Freestyle relay and 4x100 mtr Medley relay.
